Limassol Town

Limassol is the second largest city of the island, with stretches of sandy beaches, beautiful traditional and modern buildings as well as world-class hotels. Limassol is also known for its lively Carnival celebrations, the annual Wine Festival as well its location, which is between two ancient city-kingdoms: 'Amathus' to the east and 'Kourion' to the west, making it a popular tourist attraction.







We will start our journey through the acres of lemon tree plantations in the area of Fasouriou, where we will visit Castle of Kolossi, a fine example of military architecture. Continuing our visit near the old port, where there is housed the **Medieval Museum** and walk the graphic pathways of the old city which has been recently renovated.

Next follows a visit to the **Sanctuary of God Apollon Ylatis**, god of the woodland and protector of the kingdom Kourion, as well as a visit to **Kourion Greco-Roman theatre** which has been completely restored and is used for musical and theatrical performances in a unique location.
