Paphos Tour with Urban Aspects (Saturday 29 June, 2024)



We will leave from Nicosia at 09:00 and head for Paphos, the ancient capital of Cyprus, which lies on the west coast of the island. The modern-day town of Paphos is built on ancient ruins of the town of the Hellenistic and Roman eras. Our first stop will be at the mythological birth place of the goddess Aphrodite, a beach called "Petra tou Romiou".

We will continue our tour with a visit to the Kouklia museum. The museum is housed in

the building of a medieval manor house, close to the ruins of Palepaphos, the original site of the town of Paphos and a major worship center of the goddess Aphrodite. We will reach the harbor of Kato Paphos, for a stroll along the waterline and a stop for lunch.

After lunch we will walk to the adjacent archaeological site for a tour of the ruins of the Hellenistic and Roman era which have been designated as a UNESCO world heritage site. The walk will include a tour of the mosaic floors which depict scenes from the ancient Greek Mythology.



After our Tour of Kato Paphos we will drive to the upper part of the town for a walkshop of the recently restored urban center.

Recent urban developments will be discussed during the walkshop.

When we conclude this part of the excursion we will head back to Nicosia.
