

Anastasios Doulamis: "Computer Vision techniques in critical engineering infrastructures"



Prof. Anastasios Doulamis (M) has received the Diploma degree in Electrical and Computer Engineering from the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA) with the highest honor and the PhD degree in Electrical and Computer Engineering from NTUA. He is currently Associate Professor at the NTUA, while he has served as associate professor at the Technical University of Crete. Prof. Anastasios Doulamis has received several awards and prizes during his studies, including the Best Greek Student in all fields of engineering in national level, the Best Graduate Thesis Award in the area of Electrical Engineering and several prizes from the National Technical University of Athens, the National Scholarship Foundation and the Technical Chamber of Greece. In 1997, he was given the NTUA Medal as Best Young Engineer. He is the author of more than 450 papers in the area of computer vision, image analysis, deep learning and multimedia. He also has about 7,000 citations in the respective field.

Prof. Anastasios Doulamis is the coordinator of H2020 HEART project and served as coordinator of H2020 TERPSICHORE. He is involved in numerous H2020 projects such as euPOLIS, Heron, Incisive, Stamina, YADES, Hyperion, etc.
