# **Guidelines for Conference Platform - Easy Academia**

During the conference, ALL sessions can be accessed by logging in to the CONFERENCE PLATFORM **"EasyAcademia"**. You may login to the conference platform at any time before the conference.

Most of you have already used the platform during the abstract submission process, so you already have a username and a password to login - make sure you have those available. If you did not use "EasyAcademia" before please use the guidelines below to create an account.

# **CREATE ACCOUNT**

First, you will need to set up an account. Go to <u>www.easyacademia.org</u> and click on the "Get Started" button.
