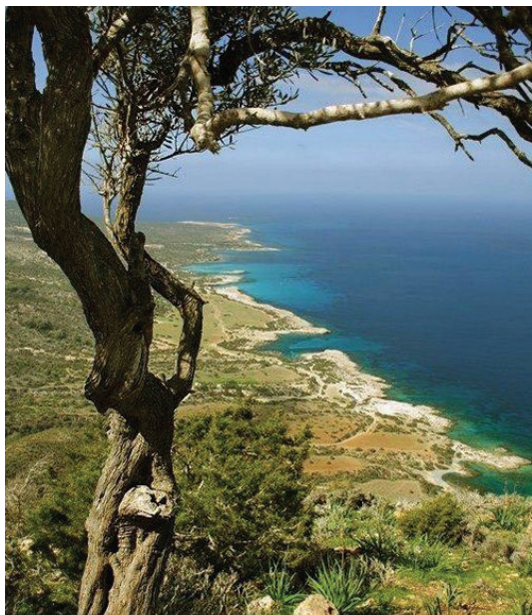
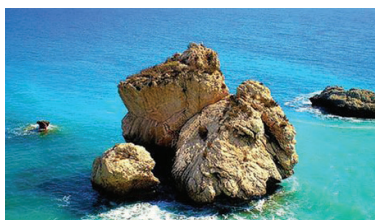


Full Day Excursion

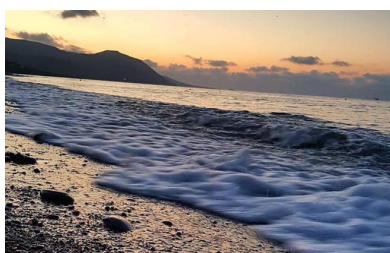
Paphos 08/10/2023



The entire town of Paphos is a listed UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring monuments of exquisite and unique beauty. Pafos was the capital of Cyprus for a long period of time in antiquity. We will depart from Royal Apollonia Hotel at 09,00 and we will firstly make a stop at Petra tou Romiou where according to mythology the Goddess of Love and Beauty was born through the foam of this sea. Then we will stop at the village of Yeroskipou where we will visit the Ayia Paraskevi church with Byzantine architecture and then visit a traditional Loukoumi factory where you can taste sweet fresh Loukoumia.



Our next stop will be the Historic City Center of Paphos where the old town was rehabilitated in 2017 to restore its public places and historical buildings so they have a great look. Then we will visit the ancient mosaics that serve us a stunning record of Grego-Roman daily life. Our lunch will take place at paphos harbor, in a local tavern



Our last stop will be the **Tombs of the Kings** This area contains underground tombs said to rest noble men, carved out of solid rock, which date back to the 3rd century B,C and causing a sense of mystery and secrecy. We expect to be back at the hotel around 17.30
