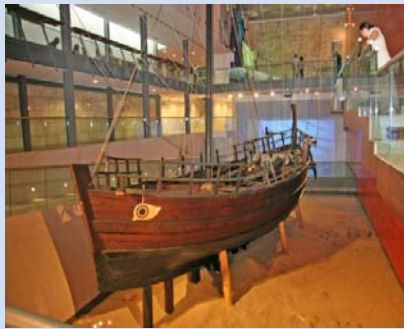


Full Day Excursion

Ayia Napa and Protaras

Ayia Napa and Protaras are considered the most popular tourist destinations on the island as Mother Nature has been very generous with. The turquoise waters, the golden glazing beaches and cosmopolitan night life and resorts make these two areas stand out.

Our trip to Ayia Napa and Protaras will firstly head towards Ayia Napa. We will first visit the Monastery of **'Ayia Napa'**. 'Ayia Napa' stands for "the Saint of the woods".



We will then move towards the town centre of Ayia Napa, in order to visit the **'Sea' Museum: "Thalassa"**. The museum features the exact life size replica of the historical "Kyrenia II" vessel of the 4th cent. BC. After our visit to this museum, we will allow time be for a short stroll at **Ayia Napa Square** for shopping and souvenir goods. We will then meet for fresh 'fish meze' at a traditional tavern.

Our next visit will be to **Cape Greco** at Protaras. The **'chapel of Ayioi Anargyroi'** is part of Cape Greco National Park which is located at the very northwest part of Ayia Napa on a prime location. The area attracts hundreds of tourists for the unique beauty of the sea- washed curved rocks. The place is ideal and idyllic at the same time for shooting photos and that is why we will be staying there until sunset time.

On our way back through Paralimni, we will stop at Famagusta 'ghost point'. This is the border point at which the abandoned city of Famagusta can be seen in the way its inhabitants left it after the Turkish occupation of 1974.
