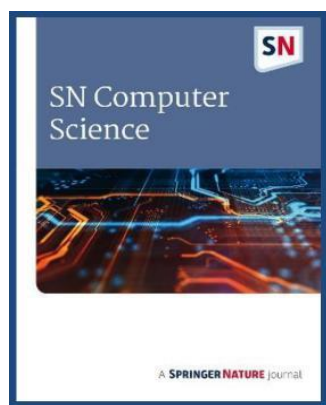




Call for Papers Topical Issue of SN Computer Science:
